Property & Campground Rules

- Absolutely <u>NO</u> usage of firearms, explosives, illegal drugs, or fireworks is allowed anywhere on the property of Cave Without a Name.
- Eclipse viewing at Cave Without a Name is exclusive to campers only. Non-paying guests are NOT allowed. Your friends are welcome, but only as paid campers.
- Check-in starts at 9 am on the first day of the event; check-out time is at 4 pm on the final event day. You must be 21 to book a camp spot, and no one under 18 can be admitted without a parent or guardian.
- Come early. **Tent camping** spots are selected on a first-come basis. Unload your equipment in the roadside areas marked for unloading. Erect your tent to occupy your selected camping area. Please move your car to the designated parking areas. There is no parking allowed on the grassy areas of the grounds.
- You will receive a **wristband** at check-in, which must be worn for admittance to onground events. Bring all the pieces to the gift shop for replacement if your wristband breaks.
- At check-in, you will receive **hanger tags** that must be displayed on your vehicle, tent, or RV at all times. If not displayed, your vehicle may be towed off the grounds at the owner's expense. Vehicles blocking roads will be towed without notice at the owner's expense.
- Respect the 24-mph **speed limit** on the entry road and the 5-mph speed limit on the remaining park roads.
- The water on the property is "non-potable" (non-drinkable). Although bottled water is available at the customer center during regular business hours, you are encouraged to bring an ample water and food supply.
- Non-potable free-standing **water spigots** are available throughout the campground. This water is acceptable for washing dishes and cleaning areas but not for drinking. Fill a bucket to keep at your campsite. Do not attach a hose to the spigots.
- Respect your neighbors and the grounds by **keeping your campsite orderly**. Please bag all **trash** and place it in a designated trash container.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 7 am.
- Be considerate of others and listen to your **music with headphones**. No amplified instruments or drums are allowed.
- Campfires:
 - Please check with the Gift Shop for the current status of fires allowed on the property. Only self-contained charcoal cooking fires are permitted during Kendall County burn bans or on windy days. Campfires within the fire rings are allowed when there are no burn bans and the winds are calm.
 - o If allowed, **campfires** must be contained within a fire ring. There is to be no burning of trash or other debris such as glass, plastic, or aluminum containers. Be aware of fire hazards.
 - The cutting/gathering of any **firewood** on the property or theft of purchased wood from other sites is strictly prohibited. Bundled firewood is available for purchase during regular business hours at the Gift Shop.
 - o Do not leave your campfire unattended.
- Please leave the **restrooms and showers** clean.
- Please accompany your **children** and be aware of your surroundings.

Property & Campground Rules

- Use caution whenever you see wildlife.
- We love your **furry friends** and encourage you to bring them for the eclipse, but please remember all must remain on leashes and wear a current rabies ID Tag. You are responsible for water and shade for your pet. Since pets tend to be great escape artists (especially from tents), please don't leave them unattended.
- Please clean up after your furry family members (dogs) and dispose of **pet waste** in bags in designated trash containers.
- Drink **alcoholic beverages** responsibly. Loud, disruptive, or violent behavior resulting from intoxication will not be tolerated.
- **Smoke** only in designated areas.
- There is no tolerance for sexual misconduct, harassment, or Public Nudity.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- Drone flights are prohibited without written approval from our staff.
- **Generators** are allowed in the campground's RV and BoonDocker area but not in the tent camping area. Solar power is welcomed for all campsites.
- The **entry gate** to the property will be locked each night at 11 pm and will be opened at 8:30 am the following day. However, on the morning of Saturday, Oct. 14th, Eclipse Day, the gate will remain closed until 2 pm.
- All campground facilities are to be used at your own risk. Cave Without a Name is not liable for any injury or damages resulting from uncontrollable circumstances during your stay.
- There is no **dump station** on the property.
- Washing of vehicles of any sort is not permitted on the property.
- If you experience a serious emergency, call 911 first and notify us that emergency services are en route. We will assist in their arrival and be with you until they arrive.
