Suggested Items

During this period, traffic will be heavy, and lines for local services such as restaurants, gas stations, grocery, and retail stores may be longer than usual; do what you can ahead of time before the anticipated impact days, and allow for extra time to get where you need to go. The cave is 11 miles from Boerne via a two-lane road, so limit your trips and be!

Be sure the items on the list below are included in your camping gear.

All should consider the following:

- **Never look at the sun without special eye protection:** Bring Eclipse viewing glasses or a handheld solar viewer.
- Do not think, “We’ll just pick up what we need when we get there.” Supplies, cash, fuel, and restaurant meals may have limited services or have long lines due to high demand. Due to increased visitors to the area, there may be shortages of some items:
 - Come to the cave with a full tank of gas.
 - ATMs may be temporarily out of cash.
 - Bring cash! Due to overloaded internet, credit card usage may be problematic.
- Water (plenty of it)!
- Be self-sufficient with ample food, snacks, & other supplies for the entire time.
- Bring a fully stocked First Aid Kit.
- Bring all necessary medications for you and your pets.
- Sun protection: Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Hat/visor
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Printed maps of the area in case your cell service is interrupted.
- Ensure your vehicle/RV has been serviced and you are fueled up and ready to go (gas, propane, etc.)
- Follow the rule “Pack it in, Pack it out!”

Campers without hookups:

- Self-contained grills or propane camp stoves for cooking.
- Lawn chairs, tables, & personal shade (small umbrellas & big hats permitted.)
- No ice available on the property – consider a well-insulated ice chest.
- While it is recommended not to drink the water, it can be used to wash cooking wear, dishes, etc., so if you are camping without hookups, bring a bucket to transport water from the spigots to your campsite.
